2019 TRAVEL AWARD

FOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND PhD STUDENTS

Candidates' Requirements:

PhD students or postdoctoral researchers involved in any aspect of *Veterinary Sciences*. Application subjects may cover all aspects covered by our journal. The applicant should attend an international conference in 2019 to present their research (poster or oral presentation).

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- The conference name and website
- The applicant's oral presentation or poster abstract
- Short CV, including a complete list of publications
- A justification letter (max. 500 words) describing the focus of their research, and what benefits the applicant will get from attending the conference
- A letter of recommendation (max. 400 words) from a supervisor or PI (principal investigator). The supervisor or PI should sign and confirm that the applicant fulfills all the requirements

Please submit your applications to vetsci@mdpi.com by **15 November 2018**. The winner will be informed via email and also announced on the homepage of *Veterinary Sciences* by the middle of **December 2018**.

The award consists of **800 CHF (or 810 USD/720 EUR)**. Each winner is welcome to publish one paper in *Veterinary Sciences* free of charge.
