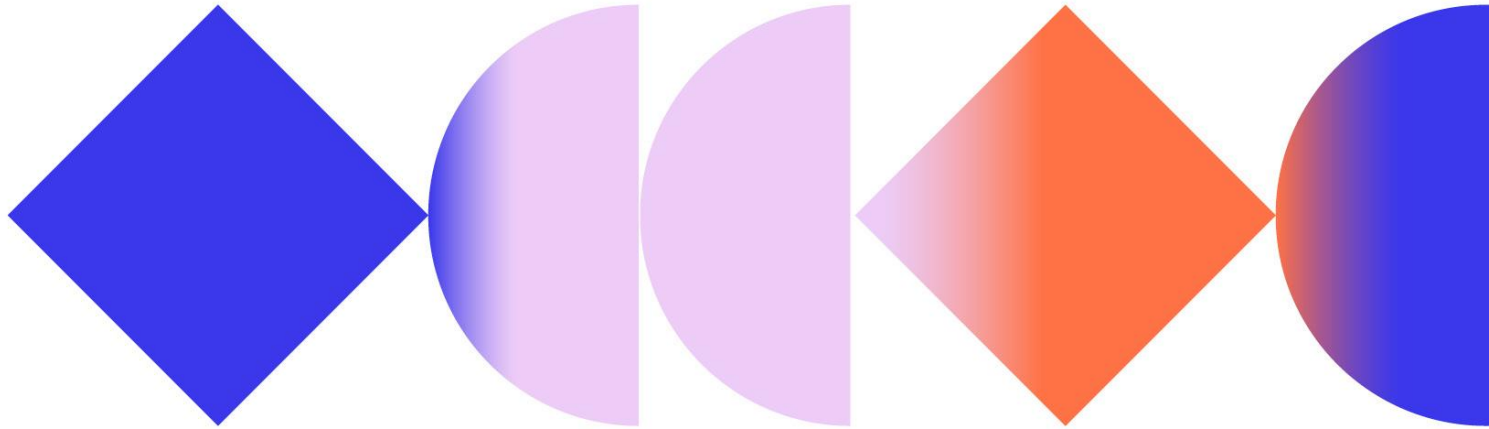

# What are Joint Teaching Units? Who can attend?



As part of Una Europa's Mobility in Emergency, academics from the One Health Community have jointly organized education activities for their classes with embedded forms of interaction among the participating students from the Una Europa universities.

In the current pilot phase, the Joint Teaching Units are **recorded lectures of variable length on a specific One Health-related topic, followed by a live Q&A session**. The joint live sessions offer a platform for students to engage in a discussion with the lecturer and students from other Una Europa universities.

Students are invited to browse the course offer and get registered for the lectures they are interested in.

Lecturers from all Una Europa universities are invited to promote this joint offer by recommending classes to their students.

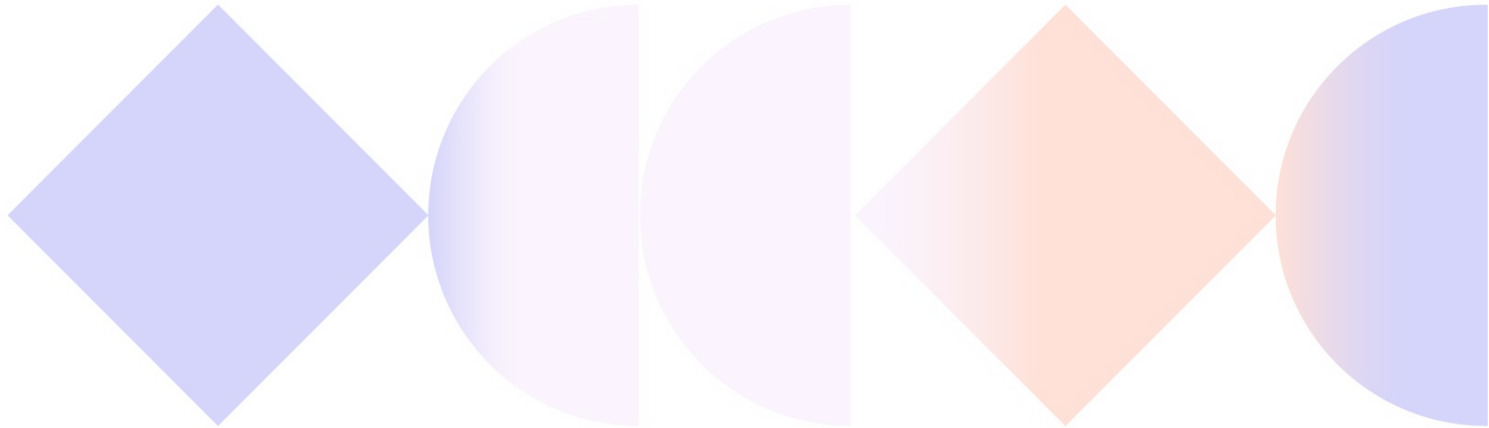
# How to attend?

# Una Europa One Health



The health of humans, animals, other organisms and the environment are inextricably linked. As proven by the Covid-19 pandemic, health challenges that stem from the complex interaction between humans, animals, plants and ecosystems call for a review of existing concepts and methods. Tighter collaboration across sectors and disciplines – more holistic One Health approaches – are crucial.

Una Europa is an alliance of eight leading European research-intensive universities with a joint mission: building a university of the future. We pilot initiatives to rethink higher education, aiming for impact across education, research and service to society.

One Health is one of Una Europa's interdisciplinary Focus Areas and Una Europa's One Health community has received Una Europa Seed Funding to initiate and deepen its collaboration. Collaboration encompasses joint research, teaching and outreach activities, such as a joint session on Lessons learned from the epidemic held on One Health Day in the fringes of the 2020 World One Health Congress.
